

## **Catonsville High School AP Scholars Program**

**The AP Scholars Program started at Catonsville High School in 2005 to encourage students to take a range of AP courses and recognize their achievement in the most demanding courses offered at CHS. The most selective colleges in the United States expect freshman applicants to take a number of AP courses in high school to be competitive for admission. There are two categories of AP scholars at CHS:**

### **AP Scholar with Distinction**

**Students must complete 6 AP courses which must be in 4 different content areas plus two courses from any area:  
English  
Social Studies  
Mathematics  
Science**

### **AP Scholar**

**Students must complete 4 AP courses which must be in 4 different content areas:  
English  
Social Studies  
Mathematics  
Science**

**To be named an AP Scholar or an AP Scholar with Distinction at the end of senior year, a student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0, earn a grade of B or better in each AP course, and take the AP exam for each course. Each AP Scholar will receive a certificate and honor cord and be recognized at the Senior Awards Ceremony.**
